From the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control

*Phase 1b—Essential Frontline Workers (Late Winter 2021)*

*Phase 1c—65+, 16+ at high risk, Essential workers (Early Spring 2021)*

*Phase 2—Available to all people (Expected late Spring 2021)*

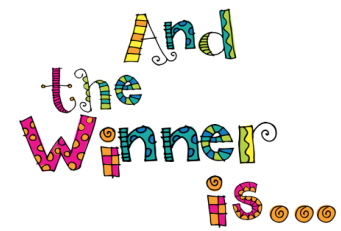
